Personal crises or unbearable, chronic, emotional pain brought many of us to CoDA. We came to our first meeting feeling hopeless and helpless. We wondered why our efforts to fix ourselves and others were not working, no matter how hard we tried. We had come to a crossroad: continue our old ways of coping or look for a new way out of our pain.

CODA - A PROGRAM OF RECOVERY FROM CODEPENDENCE, WHERE EACH OF US MAY SHARE OUR EXPERIENCE, STRENETH, AND HOPE IN OUR EFFORTS TO FIND FREEDOM WHERE THERE HAS BEEN BONDAGE, AND PEACE WHERE THERE HAS BEEN TURNOLIN OUR RELATIONSHIPS WITH OTHERS AND QUIESTIVES.

#### WHAT IS A MEETING?

A CoDA meeting is comprised of a group of people who come together around their shared desire for healthy and loving relationships. The group uses the Twelve Steps and **Twelve Traditions of Co-Dependents Anonymous** as the basis for working toward recovery. It is a place to find sponsorship and fellowship as well as the sharing of experience, strength, and hope. A strong sense of acceptance and community makes a meeting attractive to both the newcomer and old-timer.





Last April, as part of National Rx Take Back Day, PACE Coalition and the Elko County Sheriff's Office collected 54 pounds of unused medication, contributing to the more than two tons collected in Nevada and the 332 tons collected nationally.

Removing unused medication from homes ensures that they won't pose a safety risk to family members or to visitors who may be struggling with substance use.
